D300 Final Trench Report  
RQC

**D300** is an irregularly-shaped area ~15m long north-south by ~10m wide east-west at widest point. D300 is bounded to north by large spine wall **D103** (prytaneion) and to south by wall **D310** (Archaic architecture to south). Western border is wall **D312**, eastern border is a line running north-south ~1 meter east of the corner of **D209** and **D210**. Trench D300 contains three architectural structures. The eastern corner of an **LMIIC building** with a raised platform lies in the north-eastern portion of the trench just south of wall **D103**. Two Archaic rooms are preserved in the southern portion of the trench, these are aligned roughly north-south. The **northernmost, smaller Archaic room** is ~4.5m north-south by ~3.5m east-west, containing a stone bench in the northeastern corner, an olive press in the southeastern corner, lines of plakas on floor surface, and a stepped threshold with door pivot in the northwestern corner. Room is bounded to north by wall **D305**, to east by wall **D306**, to south by wall **D307**, and to west by wall **D314**. Wall **D307** is also the northern boundary of the second, larger Archaic room to south. The smaller Archaic room was excavated to floor level this season. The **southernmost, larger Archaic room** is ~7m north-south by ~4m east-west with a doorway (probably stepped) in the center of the southern wall. Floor surface of this room is lower than that of northern Archaic room. Southern Archaic room was excavated to rock tumble level this season, in which several pithos scatters were exposed. Room was excavated to level of roofing clay/destruction layer in the southernmost ~2m of the room. Room is bounded to north by wall **D307**, to east by wall **D306**, to south by wall **D310**, and to west by wall **D312**.

Portions of this trench above and around the LMIIC building corner were excavated as part of trench **D200**, trench supervisor was Mark Alonge.

Excavation in D300 area this season was conducted to determine whether any features associated with large spine wall **D103** and/or Archaic storage/processing complex to south were present in the area. Excavation began 21 June 04 and ended 12 July 04. The trench supervisor was Rob Cuthrell. Trench assistants were Clara Scarry, Rachel McCleery, Carolyn Edey, and Cait Johnson. The trench workers were XXX.

**LMIIC Corner:**

Topsoil in and around the LMIIC corner in the northern portion of the trench was excavated as part of trench **D200** by Mark Alonge. Topsoil and slopewash was removed as pails in loci **D201**, **D202**, and **D204**. The uppermost portions of walls **D209** and **D210** were exposed with these passes. The portion of **D200** south of wall **D103** was afterward excavated as **D300**.

Pails **D301.1-3** were the initial passes removing topsoil and slopewash in a trench extension south of the exposed portion of the LMIIC corner. These passes defined the area around large boulder in wall **D210** and exposed bedrock to east and south of LMIIC corner.

Pails **D302.1-5** continued to remove slopewash in the area above and around the LMIIC corner. After pail **D302.1**, the interior space bounded by walls **D209** and **D210** was defined as locus **D303**. Pails **D302.2-4** defined the area outside of locus **D303**. The northern edge of wall **D209** was defined with this pass, along with the southern face of **D103** and the area to west of raised platform. Southeastern face of **D210** defined, bedrock exposed in this area.

Pails **D302.6-9** continued to define the area around LMIIC corner through removal of slopewash transitioning to light tumble. Area west of raised platform and around what was thought to be a possible stone bench was defined. Area immediately west of raised platform was excavated with these pails, raised platform found not to be floor surface after excavation exposed western face of wall **D304**. Area between walls **D209** and **D103** was further defined. A possible stone bowl fragment was recovered in pail **D302.6**. Pail **D302.8** removed a linear accumulation of stones previously thought to be a wall abutting wall **D209**. Pail **D302.9** removed an accumulation of stones previously thought to be a stone bench abutting large boulder of wall **D210**.

Pail **D302.10** removed packed grayish clay west of wall **D209** in an attempt to find an adjoining wall (none found). Pails **D302.13-16** removed pebbly grayish clay in the area west and to south of the end of wall **D209** and around the northeast corner of walls **D305** & **D306**. These pails also failed to find a wall associated with **D209**.

Pails **D303.1-6** removed rock tumble from the interior space bounded by walls **D209** and **D210**. A linear accumulation of stones abutting wall **D210** at a 45 degree angle and running towards wall **D209** was exposed at the bottom of **D303.4**. The top of a built stone plaka was also exposed at the bottom of **D303.4**. Pail **D303.5** exposed the surface of the raised platform in the eastern corner of the room. Platform bounded by walls **D209**, **D210**, and **D304**. A two-course built plaka feature was exposed near the corner of walls **D209** and **D210**, top plaka stone is ~15x20cm. Two other small, flat stones embedded in platform surface were exposed, both less than ~10cm in diameter. A stone quern, broken, ~10cm in diameter, was exposed embedded in platform surface to north of built plaka, dark stain present on surface of quern. Excavation to west of the raised platform showed the floor surface of LMIIC building to be destroyed, only clay fill/rock tumble remains in this area.

**North Archaic Room:**

Pails **D301.4-6** were the initial passes over topsoil in an extension of the trench south and west. Extension was made to determine whether any features associated with

LMIIC corner existed in this area. No features exposed with these passes. Pails **D302.11-12** removed slopewash/tumble from trench extension area and exposed walls **D306** and **D305**. Pails **D301.13** and **D301.14** removed topsoil/slopewash from the western edge of northern Archaic room above wall **D314** area, no features exposed. A cut (?) schist object was recovered from pail **D301.13**, and a small rounded stone tool was recovered from pail **D301.14**.

Pails **D302.17-19** removed tumble from in and around northern Archaic room to expose roofing clay mixed with tumble above the floor surface. Pail **D302.17** removed rock tumble from area above northern and southern Archaic rooms and exposed wall **D307** and the olive press (60x40cm, shallow sandstone basin with drain) as well as a built feature in the northeastern corner of northern Archaic room that was thought to be a bin (later found to be a bench). The top of the threshold stepping stone as well as the door pivot were exposed with this pass. Pail **D302.18** removed the last of rock tumble from inside the northern Archaic room, exposed roofing clay at bottom. After these pails, all material removed from northern Archaic room was taken as part of locus **D308**. Pails **D308.2** and **D309.19** removed slopewash/tumble from above wall **D314**, defined the lowest (only) preserved course of the wall.

Pails **D308.1,3-9** removed grey roofing clay and tumble from above the floor surface of northern Archaic room, defined features within the room. Pail **D308.1** removed some last slopewash remaining above grey roofing clay in the room. Pail **D308.3** exposed a small deep patch of surface in the northwestern corner of the room and defined area around threshold/door pivot. Pail **D308.4** continued this pass over the rest of the room to bring it down towards surface. Accumulation of flat stones in the southern portion of the room was removed after this pass. A quern fragment was exposed and recovered from the area just east of door pivot with this pass. Pails **D308.5-6** were another pass over surface of northern room, stone "bin" was defined, determined to be a bench, several stones removed from the area. Another accumulation of stones thought to be a stone bench abutting wall **D305** in the northern portion of the room was defined, determined to be tumble, removed. The area around the olive press was defined with this pass, large stone supporting olive press was exposed, olive press was determined to be built above floor surface. Floor surface was exposed in the southwestern corner of the trench with this pass. Central lines of plakas were exposed. The base of a possible settling vessel (~10cm diameter, irregular shape, partial drain?) was exposed embedded directly beneath olive press drain. Pails **D308.7-8** removed remaining roofing clay and stones in isolated spots around the room to define features and bring the remaining high areas down to the floor surface. An iron blade was recovered between stones just north of olive press in pail **D308.7**. Pail **D308.9** removed the embedded settling vessel base underneath olive press. No excavation occurred in northern Archaic room after removal of settling vessel base.

#### **South Archaic Room:**

Pails **D301.7-10** were the initial passes over topsoil in a southern extension of the trench following wall **D306** south. Pails **D301.7,9-10** removed soil above wall **D306** in south room area, pails **D301.8-9** removed soil from above bedrock. One polished stone recovered from pail **D301.9**. No excavation east of wall **D306** after pail **D301.9**, sterile bedrock in this area. One rounded stone tool recovered from pail **D301.10**. Pail **D301.12** removed topsoil in another trench extension south of western half of wall **D307**, an elongated ground stone tool, broken, was recovered from this pail. Pail **D301.15-17**

removed topsoil/slopewash from interior of southern Archaic room in an additional trench extension to wall **D307**.

Pails **D309.3-4** were the initial passes over two more extensions of the trench southward following wall **D306**. These passes extended the trench about 4m southward and removed topsoil and slopewash. Wall **D310** was exposed by pail **D309.4**.

Pails **D309.8** was the first pass over a small westward trench extension ~2m square following wall **D310** west looking for the room's fourth wall. Wall **D310** was exposed in this area, no corner was found with this pass. Pail **D309.9** completed part of the pass started by **D309.8** in the small westward trench extension, then extended the trench ~2m westward and ~6m northward to wall **D307**. Topsoil and slopewash removed, no features revealed. Pails **D309.10-11** removed topsoil/slopewash from the westward trench extension area from wall **D310** to **D307**. Pail **D309.13** removed topsoil/slopewash from the southwestern corner of the trench in an area where high soil was obscuring part of corner of walls **D310** and **D312**.

Pail **D302.17** removed slopewash and tumble from interior of north and south Archaic rooms, only covered northern half of the southern Archaic room. Pail **D309.5** removed slopewash/tumble from a ~1 meter strip over the western edge of southern Archaic room, area above/slightly east of wall **D312**. Pail **D309.14** removed slopewash/tumble directly above wall **D312**, defined the wall across the entire western edge of the trench.

Pails **D309.1-2,6-7,12 ; D311.1-2 ; D313.2** all removed rock tumble from within the southern Archaic room. Rock tumble removal defined walls and doorway, much rock tumble/slid steps exposed in doorway. A bronze pin and possible rounded stone tool were recovered in pail **D309.1**. Another rounded stone tool was recovered in pail **D309.2**. A quern fragment and a large stone tool (~15 cm long) were recovered in pail **D309.3**. Three loom weights were recovered from the pottery in pail **D309.3**. A bronze nail was recovered from pail **D309.4**. A piece of lead and a possible quern fragment were recovered from pail **D309.8**. Pail **D311.1** exposed a layer of roofing clay and destruction layer included with carbon flecks. Pail **D311.2** exposed several pithos scatters across the northern and western edges of southern Archaic room. Excavation was suspended after pail **D311.2** due to time constraint, exposed pithos scatters were covered with soil to protect them until next season.

Pail **D313.1** removed roofing clay/destruction layer in a ~2m wide sondage in the southern portion of the southern Archaic room. Some burnt soil removed, doorway further defined with this pass, appears to be stepped, steps not well preserved.

#### Discussion:

D300 represents a transitional area between the Archaic storage/processing complex to the south and the prytaneion to the north. D300 appears to contain the northernmost portion of the storage/processing complex. The northernmost Archaic room in D300 appears to be a processing area for olives, as evidenced by the built olive press and settling vessel in the southeast corner of the room. Lines of plakas in the room may have supported other vessels used for separation of olive oil/waste or for storage. Stone bench in northeastern corner is not well preserved, function in association with processing material cannot be determined.

The southern Archaic room in D300 is very likely a storage room, as evidenced by pithos scatters exposed with rock tumble in northern and western portions of room. Doorway in southern wall of room may step up into another room just south of it in

unexcavated portion of the slope just west of B2200. There is a possible threshold in the western wall, though more excavation is needed inside room to determine whether this is the case.

The LMIIC building corner in the northeastern portion of the trench is useful in clarifying the way in which earlier phase architecture was modified in later phases. It appears that the western portion of this building, if it remained in the Archaic occupation, was removed to make way for the northern Archaic room, while the eastern corner of the building was left intact. Because so little of the LMIIC building is preserved, the function of the building is not clear. The raised platform that is preserved may represent a work area, as evidenced by stone quern. Platform may be a storage shelf, as suggested by small stone plakas embedded in surface and the large built plaka in the building's corner.

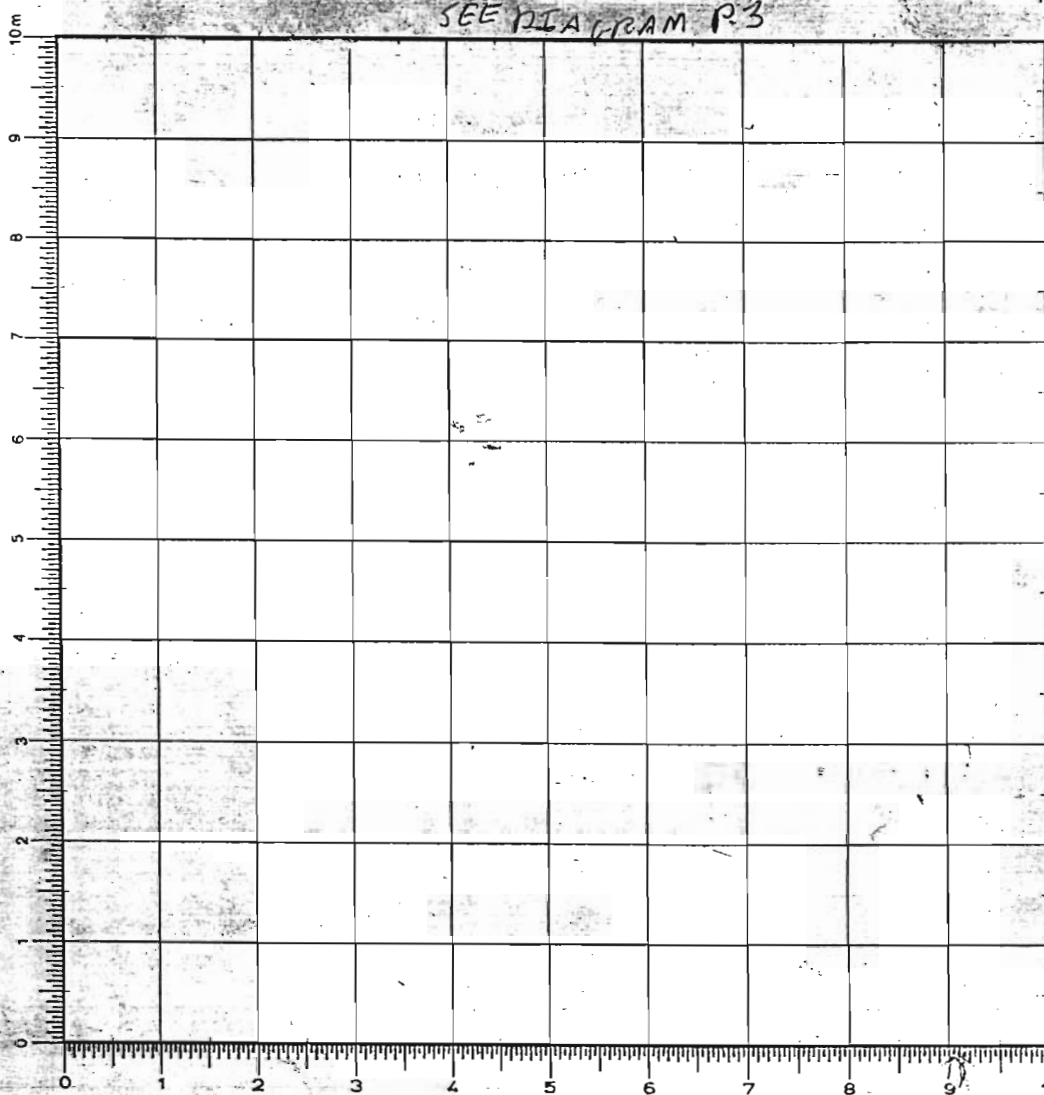

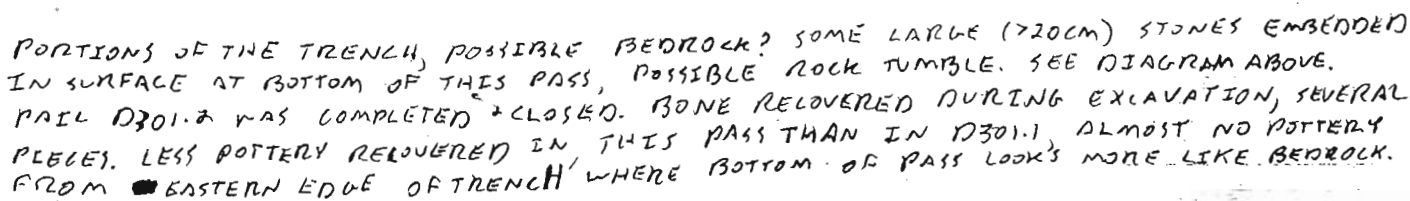

PAIL D301-2 IS A PASS OF MID CM ACROSS ENTIRE SURFACE OF D301, SOIL REMOVED IS BROWN SLOPEWASH AS IN PAIL D301-1 ABOVE. SOIL REMOVED NOT SCREENED. SOIL MATRIX IS PEBBLE & FIST-SIZE ROCKS, POTTERY. MORE ROCK TUMBLE EMERGING AT BOTTOM OF PASS, PARTICULARLY IN ~~WEST~~ EASTERN PORTION OF TRENCH. SOIL AT BOTTOM OF PASS SLIGHTLY REDDISH/LIGHTER BROWN IN EASTERN & SOUTHERN

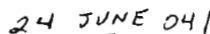


PAIL D301.3 IS A PASS OF 10 CM ~~TO~~ OVER SURFACE OF D301, PASS WILL BRING LOCUS AREA DOWN TO SAME LEVEL AS TOP OF PAIL D302.1 IN NORTHERN PORTION OF TRENCH. PAIL D301.4 WILL REMOVE ~10 CM OF SOIL FROM AREA OF TRENCH EXTENSION, SEE LOCATION IN DIAGRAM ABOVE. FIRST PASS OVER THIS AREA REMOVED 10 CM OF TOPSOIL, LOOSE ROCKS, AND SOME VEGETATION. SOIL IS BROWN, SOFT TOPSOIL/SLOPEWASH WITH FIST-SIZE ROCK & POTTERY INCLUSIONS. SOME BONE RECOVERED DURING EXCAVATION, ONE ROUNDED PEBBLE WAS RECOVERED & BAGGED. SOIL AT BOTTOM OF PASS SAME AS TOP, MORE SLOPEWASH WITH SOME EMBEDDED ROCK TUMBLE. WE ARE EXCAVATING THIS AREA TO DETERMINE WHETHER = WALLS ASSOCIATED WITH THE STRUCTURE BOUNDED BY D209 & D210 UNDERLIE THE AREA.
