Waste Plan Amendment for Pear Orchard Farm

On March 30, 2011 a temporary plan amendment was made to the Waste Management Plan for Pear Orchard Farm. In that temporary amendment due to poor fescue stand and weed issues on Tract 10486: fields 1, 4A, 4B, 5A, 5B, 6A, 6B, 7A, 7B, 8A and 8B the plant stand was destroyed and replanted to summer annual forages and then winter annual forages.

The initial plan was to re-establish a perennial forage crop of fescue. However, due the changing forage needs of the overall farm, the plan needs to change to permanently to reflect summer annual forages and winter annual forages being grown on the site. The table developed to reflect waste utilization for the temporary amendment will be adopted to reflect the new permanent plan. It will serve to amend the Waste Utilization table shown as part of the Nutrient Management Plan for Waste Utilization dated 09/16/2003.
